Key dates

The RACGP placement process is designed to equitably distribute registrars across Australia in a transparent and flexible manner.

Our open market approach, together with your valuable feedback, contributes to a placements process that affords choice for both registrars and training sites.

Facilitated through the Training Management System (TMS), this process is shaped by the needs of registrars, practices and supervisors, and bespoke priority placement support is available where required.

Our local training support teams understand that requirements vary greatly, and they are available to help registrars and training sites navigate this process.

Date	Placement Stage
Monday 16 September 2024	Training site capacity update opens.
Tuesday 1 October 2024	Registrar training intention update opens.
Monday 7 October 2024	Training site capacity update and registrar training intention update close.
Friday 18 October 2024	Final training capacity and registrar group allocation confirmed.
Monday 21 October 2024	Registrars commence applying to practices and practices can commence interviews. No offers can be made at this time.
Monday 28 October 2024	Training sites commence making offers. Registrar applications and interviews continue until all registrars have placements confirmed.
Friday 29 November 2024	Medicare provider number deadline for 2025.1.
